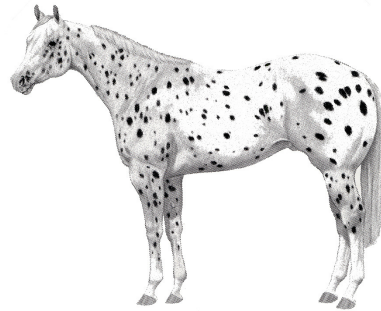

The Southern Arizona Appaloosa Promoters Open Breed Shows are intended to be safe and fun learning experiences with good sportsmanship for horse and rider. **RULES:** These shows adhere to the SAAP Rule Book and the Appaloosa Horse Club Handbook. These books can be viewed at the office or [www.saappaloosa.org](http://www.saappaloosa.org)

- Judges and/or show management have the right to excuse riders or handlers from the ring for safety or violation of rules.
- Disputes are to be given to the show office in writing, with a \$100 check, thirty minutes before the end of the show to be taken up by the show management. Decisions are final.
- Refund of scratched classes require that either horse or rider is injured, sick or frightened. Reasons must be okayed by show manager for total or partial refund. (Show manager has all rights of refusal.)

**ENTRIES:** There are no pre-show entries; enter at the show. The show office will open one hour before the start of the show. Open checks are preferred.

- **Gate Entries** will be allowed only for contestants with open checks. Notify the office that you want to enter at the gate when you sign up.

**FEES:** \$8.00 per class

\$15.00 per jackpot class (\$10 to jackpot)

\$6.00 insurance fee per horse

**AWARDS:** Ribbons 1st-5th place for each class except jackpot. High Point Awards will be given at each show in these divisions: Young Youth, Older Youth, Youth Walk-Trot, Adult Walk Trot, Non-Pro, Appaloosa, Open

### **Jackpot Payouts are as follows:**

1-3 entries 1st-100%

4-6 entries 1st-60%; 2nd 40%

7+ entries 1st-50%; 2nd 30%; 3rd 20%

**Directions to Brandi Fenton Memorial Park:** Located between Campbell Ave. and Dodge Blvd. on River Rd. Entrance to arena area is West of Dodge Blvd on River Rd. **3482 E. River Road**

**Required Attire:** Helmet, English boots (or jodhpur shoes), shirt with collar, and jackets are required. Jackets may be excused by Judge due to heat. For equitation, a collared shirt with tie or pin is required.

**DEFINITIONS**

**Jackpot Classes:** Jackpot classes are classes in which the participant pays an entry fee and competes to win a cash payout. The total paid out is based on the number of horses in the class. (If you are a Non-Pro or Youth Rider competing in breed shows, please check your national club rules on winning money.)

**Non-Pro Rider:** Any rider, age 19 and older, who is not a professional or trainer.

**Walk-Trot Rider:** Any beginner novice rider not ready to canter. Rider cannot enter into other divisions or classes. Youth walk-trot are ages 18 and under.

**Youth Rider:** Rider's age as of January 1, 2010 is for the whole year. Young Youth: Ages 13 and under. Older Youth: Ages 14-18.

**Appaloosa Horse:** Horses must show Appaloosa characteristics or be ApHC registered.

**Green Horse:** A horse in it's first or second year of showing. All green horse classes are walk-trot. Green horses may enter in canter classes.

**Open Horse:** Open to all horses and riders. (No walk trot riders, green horses allowed.)

**Gate Calls and Tack Changes:** Riders and handlers are responsible for being on time and checking in at the Gate with their back number one class before their class is due to enter the ring. Gate calls will not be made for missing riders nor will the gate be held for late riders. A 3-minute tack change will be allowed only if the Gate and Announcer are notified 3 classes in advance.

**Patterns:** All patterns will be posted. Copies will be available at the show office.

**Trail Classes** will be judged by a separate judge. Trail hours will be posted at the show office. Please do not wait until the last second to do trail.
